

Christmas in the Valley Scholarship

Guidelines

- Grade point average of 85% for four years (Transcript must accompany this application)
- Student must be a graduating high school senior from the area served by the Chamber
- Extracurricular activities(Community involvement)
- The student shall have submitted an application to an accredited school (four years or less, including vocational training institutes)
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed for acceptance
- Selected and final decision will be made by the selection Committee of Christmas in the Valley

Special Requirements

- Student must submit a 400 work narrative to be read by the scholarship committee which will include the student's future plans(career, life style, contribution to society)and how this scholarship would affect those future plans

******The narrative shall be typed.** It should be submitted to the Chamber Office on 10 Bridge St. in Rumford along with the completed application form no later than May 1. The essay will then be evaluated by the scholarship committee for clarity of expression, conciseness, and content.

Guidelines For Fund Administration

The student pursuing a two year or a four year program will be awarded \$250.00 during the first year, paid directly to the student on completion of the 1st semester and presentation of her/his grade point average transcript to the Chamber Office. Written proof of return to college for the 2nd semester must also be made at that time.

If the student does not complete her/his course of studies, the funds will revert to the Scholarship Committee to be awarded to a student attending college, from that same graduating class.
